The Pastor's Corner

My dear Parishioners,
 With this fourth and last Sunday of Advent, we enter into a very short week of final preparation for the Feast of our Lord's Nativity. This blessed season of Advent glides in and out of our lives so smoothly — almost imperceptibly — that we are left wondering how it happened so quickly. Which leads me to think that we ought to observe a "Little Advent" in November just to gear up for this swift running month that pauses for no one as it moves steadily on its course.

It is a pity that this December has been so filled with distractions. I am not referring so much to those little events among American Christians that anticipate "Christmas," though I do wonder how they crept into Advent. No! I am concerned more about the bigger problems—challenges, if you will—that confront us: the global and national divisiveness that underlies so much of the unrest and disillusionment and pain that taint the lives of so many good people. The never-ending struggle for basic human rights not just overseas, but sadly even in this country! How do you welcome Christ into this messy world? Realistically, though, has the world ever been otherwise? The scale may be greater today, but our situation is no different than that in any other age. Which is precisely why "the Word became Flesh and dwelt among us." That Word will continue to enter our messy world until the end of time not in some magical way, but through people like us and untold others who stand in the shadow of the cross, even as you and I gather around the radiant crib. Both they and we are called to proclaim the same message in our day to our world. May the Spirit strengthen and inspire us to deliver it.

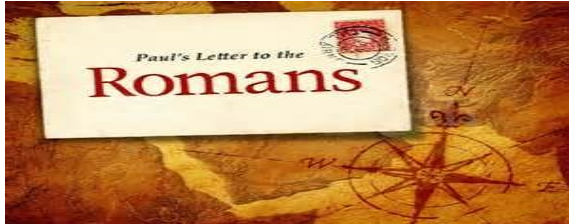

Cuarto Domingo de Adviento

• Resumiendo el mensaje del Adviento

En los Domingos pasados, la Palabra de Dios nos ha hablado de un adviento, de espera, que apunta hacia el futuro de plenitud que algún día alcanzaremos, pero que al mismo tiempo compromete al creyente a mantener una actitud de **VIGILANCIA** atenta a los valores del Evangelio (Primer Domingo).

Esta esperanza activa tiene que tener una expresión muy concreta: **anunciar el consuelo que Dios dará al pueblo de Israel y comprometer la vida propia a ser portadores, de palabra y de obra, de este mensaje de Dios, por que El ya nos ha enviado a su hijo Jesucristo** (Segundo Domingo).

Esta esperanza empapada de amor transforma el espíritu del creyente y vive en la **ALEGRÍA** de la proximidad siempre alentadora de Dios (Tercer Domingo).

Este cuarto Domingo va a fijar nuestra atención en el inmediato cumplimiento de la promesa de Dios pero con unos matices altamente interesantes que nos pueden ayudar a colocarnos adecuadamente en el marco de los planes de Dios.

• ¿Cómo honrar a Dios?

El libro de Samuel presenta la figura del rey David en un momento de grandeza y de poder. Desea honrar a Dios y transformar el lugar donde reside el arca de la alianza en una casa digna de El. Sin embargo, la mayor manera de rendir alabanza a Dios **será permitiendo que El nos honre a nosotros.** Nuestras obras son importantes, pero lo son mas las suyas. Es provechoso promover iniciatias en clave evangélica, pero lo es mucho mas reconocer lo que El ya ha hecho por nosotros. Mas que gastar energías en el proyecto de lo que el hombre puede hacer por Dios nos urge **discernir en el silencio y al oración el Proyecto que Dios tiene sobre nosotros.** En los momentos de éxitos y bonanza, la tentación de soberbia puede desplazar la centralidad de Dios al olvido o al recuerdo vago y estéril. Sacerdotes y laicos necesitamos **ahondar en todo lo que Dios ha hecho por nosotros.** Esta es la gran tarea que debemos encarar y asumir con total convicción si queremos en verdad agradar a Dios y colaborar con El en la Obra de la Redención realizada por Cristo. El nos invita a esta gran misión. Formar el Nuevo Pueblo de Dios en la justicia y en la verdad. En otras palabras viviendo de acuerdo al evangelio. A los diez mandamientos.

Que este sea nuestro propósito y nuestro esfuerzo en esta Navidad del 2014.
