The Pastor's Corner

My dear Parishioners,

This weekend we welcome Very Reverend Robert Joerger, Provincial of the Passionist Province of St. Paul of the Cross, to lead our celebration of the feast of our holy Patron and the 60th Anniversary of the founding of our Parish. Though the actual date is November 14th, it is most appropriate to link the founding of the Parish with the Founder of the Passionist Congregation and Patron of the Parish.

Our celebration also concurs with the Church's observance of World Mission Sunday, and this is highly significant. On this day Catholics throughout the world come to Mass to recommit themselves to their baptismal calling to be missionaries. Today, we Catholics of this parish honor our Patron, and missionary *par excellence*, St. Paul of the Cross. When a parish is named for a particular saint, it is not just a nice thing to do; it is meant to establish a spiritual bond between the people of the parish and their saintly patron. The patron becomes a heavenly intercessor for the parish and parish looks to its special patron for inspiration and guidance. But there is more: to some degree, should the parishioners not emulate in their own lives the life of their patron? An ideal way for us to do this is by serving our world, as Paul of the Cross served his, as missionaries.

As we mark these sixty years of existence as a parish, it is well for us to remember the past with sincere gratitude for all that has been accomplished, but it is equally important for us to look to the future with ardent hope. Presently, it seems the Spirit is stirring us to use our time, talent and treasure in a concerted missionary effort to evangelize, to announce the Good News to one another and, together, to bring its joyful message to our neighbors whoever and wherever they may be. Our holy Patron never spared himself in bring the Good News to the people of his time, especially the poor and forgotten. But he also spent countless hours in solitude and contemplation. As we move into the future as a parish, we would do well to discern what the Lord is asking each of us to do as his missionaries. And may the Passion of Jesus Christ be always in our hearts!

En 1713, a los 19 años, Pablo tuvo una vivencia interior de gran importancia para el futuro. La predicación de un sacerdote, le impresionó tanto que hizo confesión general. Entonces conoció que Dios le llamaba por un camino especial y respondió dedicando toda su vida al Señor.

- **La segunda** parte de la celebración de la "familia Pasionista" será compartir un 'picnic', compartir la mesa familiar. Como gran familia pasionista queremos recrearnos juntos. Compartir nuestras experiencias. Gozar de la creatividad que algunos de nuestros hermanos compartirán mediante las 'danzas nativas' etc. etc.
