My dear Parishioners,

In the ordinary calendar of the year, October signals the beginning of the Fall Season, a time when we start saying our goodbyes to the warm days of summer and our hellos to winter. October is a transitional month with lots of important things happening at least during this October. For example, today is Respect Life Sunday throughout the United States and it also marks the opening of the Church's Synod on the Family in Rome. October has also been observed for ages as the month of the Holy Rosary. And, we must not forget, during this month of October, our parish will celebrate the feast of our heavenly patron, St. Paul of the Cross and at the same time formally mark the Diamond Jubilee of the Parish.

All of the above fit very nicely into the transitional frame of October, for each event or activity does imply movement. On Respect life Sunday, and, indeed, throughout the entire month, we are challenged to think outside the box, so to speak, when we consider life issues in this 21st century world.
