The Pastor's Corner

My dear Parishioners,

Today our Parish joins the Knights of Peter Claver, the Knights of Peter Claver Ladies Auxiliary, and the junior members in celebrating Founders Day. Coming as it does in the course of Black Catholic History Month, it provides us with a wonderful opportunity to recall and acclaim the achievement of black Catholics in this country.

While such an observance is of utmost important for the whole community, I believe it provides the younger generation with an ideal opportunity to learn about and appreciate the history of their race. Today many young people can so easily be captivated by modern technology, riveted to the present moment, lost to the living reality all about them. This is true also of many adults, but my concern is that we take advantage of this opportunity to educate—and re-educate—our youth and perhaps ourselves about the painful yet admirable struggle of an oppressed people to attain their basic human rights in this “land of the free and home of the brave.” The black Catholic perspective should always influence our attitude and involvement in this continuing struggle; for it has always bolstered the human spirit, enabling the oppressed to recognize their involvement in and with the sufferings of Christ.

Among the outstanding individuals who have personified this stance is Father Augustus Tolton, a former slave who became the first black American priest. His heroic life is an inspiration to people of all races and cultures because it so powerfully portrays the life of a disciple totally committed to Christ and his Church. We pray that his saintliness may soon be officially recognized by the Universal Church. A brochure containing a brief biography of Father Tolton is enclosed in your Sunday Bulletin today.

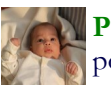

Mis queridos Hermanos, en estos ultimos domingos del ano liturgico somos invitados a reafirmar nuestra esperanza en la vida eterna. El evangelio de hoy nos insistira en que debemos trabajar los dones que Dios nos ha confiado, para ser asi dignos de "pasar al banquete de nuestro Senor". En la primera lectura (Proverbios 31,10 s, escuchamos el elogio pronunciado por un sabio del Antiguo Testamento a una buena esposa. El elogio basado en su capacidad del trabajo y en su fe confiada en el Senor.

En la segunda lectura, san Pablo responde a los tesalonicenses en su preocupacion por saber cuando ocurrira el fin del mundo y que sucederia aquel dia . Pablo les escribe para tranquilizarlos y para exhortarlos a estar preparados.

El valor del tiempo presente

Despues de la fiesta de la dedicacion de la Basilica de Letran, volvemos al T. Ordinario en este penultimo domingo del ciclo liturgico. Como es norma sabida, la liturgia de la Iglesia nos situa en estas ultimas semanas frente al futuro de la humildad, ante la segunda venida del Senor al fin de los tiempos. fomenta en nosotros lo que podriamos llamar "una vision escatologica" de la historia. ES decir, valorar el tiempo presente mirando hacia la meta, hacia la consumacion final. Por eso en el evangelio, Jesus evita dar datos informativos sobre el fin del mundo. Es que, el no ha venido a satisfacer nuestra curiosidad o a calmar nuestras angustias sino a enseñarnos a vivir de cara a Dios.

Si, mis Hermanos, Jesus nos trae una manera de vivir, de situarnos en este mundo que es, al mismo tiempo, transitorio y necesario. Porque es transitorio no podemos dar a lo que aqui hacemos un valor definitivo. Y porque es un tiempo necesario, como tiempo de prueba y de crecimiento, hemos de valorar positivamente las realidades de este mundo. Son un don de Dios para que ejercitemos nuestra libertad y autonomia, sin caer en la tentacion de la "huida del mundo". En fin, pienso que todo esto lo superaremos en la medida que nos esforcemos en vivir de acuerdo al evangelio. Esa vivencia clara no solo sera un testimonio de hombres de fe sino tambien, la garantia de una sana preparacion para el encuentro final con el Dios de la Vida. Que en este caminar de fe, Maria Sma. sea nuestra madre y guia.
